A: Any therapist or research staff trained and delegated

INVESTIGATOR MEETING Q&A

Q: Who can sign off eligibility?

A: A delegated surgeon or clinician who routinely lists patients as eligible for surgery.

Q: How long after a patient is allocated ENGAGE should the package start? A: Within 8 weeks where possible

Q: What can Associate PIs do?
